1. Join Us for the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity, January 18-25












January 18-25, 2025 is **Week of Prayer for Christian Unity.** WPCU is an annual ecumenical celebration when Christians around the world are invited to pray for the unity of all Christians, to reflect on scripture together, to participate in jointly-organized ecumenical services, and to share fellowship.

<u>2025 WPCU resources</u> are now available for download. The 2025 theme, prepared by the monastic community of Bose in Northern Italy, "*Do you believe this?*" (*John 11:26*). Resources for 2025 include marking the 1,700th anniversary of the first Christian Ecumenical Council of Nicaea.
