ELCIC Mission Fund Grant Applications

We are inviting applications for grants to fund neighbourhood and community experiments and learning opportunities that meet one or more of the following criteria:

- a) explore what God is doing in your neighbourhood
- b) seek to develop relationships with others in your community
- c) encourage participation in God's mission in the local community
- d) encourage action and reflection learning

Through these experiments, we will continue to learn from and with each other as we share our stories, experiences, and our learning with the rest of our synod and the wider church. Experiments need not be large-scale or require the commitment of large dollar amounts. Successful applications are inspired by imagination and a curiosity about what God is up to in our midst.

Grants are funded by the ELCIC through the ELCIC Mission Fund and are given on a one-time basis and are not intended to subsidize ongoing funding needs of regular church programming. Grant recipients will be invited to submit the "faith story" of their missional experiments, which will be shared with the synod and the communities and be asked to give an accounting of how the grant money is spent, and to return any unused funds.

The application deadline is February 15, 2025.

Please note that all congregations and groups that receive funding must complete the reporting form when their experiment is complete. This allows us to reconcile funds and report to the National Church, which is a requirement of our committee. It also gives you a chance to reflect with your team and share your experience with us. BC Synod delegate fees for National Convention


The 2025 ELCIC National Convention will take place July 10 – 13, 2025 in Winnipeg, Manitoba. Of the 150 delegates attending the National Convention, 20 will be from the BC Synod, comprised of 12 lay delegates (which include 8 younger delegates aged 16-30) and 8 rostered delegates. The selection of these delegates took place at the June 2024 BC Synod Convention.

In accordance with the [discernment process](#) for electing a new national bishop, the ELCIC is [providing the following link](#) for the pre-identification process, to which individuals have the opportunity to identify someone with the skills and gifts for the call to serve as national bishop. This pre-identification process will place through to March 31, 2025.

Pre-identified candidates will need endorsement from eight ELCIC members - four rostered and four lay. Each ELCIC member is eligible to provide endorsement of one individual throughout this process.
